As many of us have chatted about and discussed various ways we can improve our club thru more fellowship, more members, etc. we're launching a couple of things that the officers believe will help with these areas.

In the past, the club used to meet on a monthly basis. For various reasons we moved away from that format and reverted to 'meetings at the ramp' which took us further away from our charter of emphasizing fellowship amongst the club members.. It also has made it difficult to recruit and retain guests. So, we are going to reinstate the monthly meeting format.
